The Addison County Solid Waste Management District (ACSWMD) is soliciting bids for one (1) New 48' Tandem-Axle, Aluminum, Closed-Top, Compactor-Compatible Recycling Transfer Trailer. Bids must meet the minimum specifications found on the attached page. Terms: Net 30 Days. All bids must be submitted on the Bid Form attached to this Request for Bids (RFB). Late bids will be rejected. Terms: Net 30 Days.

DISTRICT BACKGROUND

The ACSWMD is a tax-exempt, 501(C)(1) union municipal district made up of 21 member towns, with a population of 36,200. The ACSWMD operates a 70-ton-per-day (21,676 tons/year) Transfer Station at 1223 Rt. 7 South, in Middlebury, VT for Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) and Construction & Demolition Debris (C&D). The Facility also collects approximately 4,000 tons/year of single stream recyclables and a variety of special wastes (electronic waste, appliances and scrap metal, tires, etc.) for transport by trailers to other facilities. Single stream recyclables are fed into a stationary compactor that loads into a closed-top aluminum transfer trailer. This new trailer will be an addition to our fleet, with no trade-in equipment to offer.

BID SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Bids must be received by 4:00 PM (EST), Tuesday, August 3, 2021.
- 2. Responses must include the following elements:

Aluminum Closed-Top Transfer Trailer

- The completed Bid Form attached;
- Product description detailed enough to determine compliance with minimum specifications, including cubic yards and weight. Bidder is responsible for ensuring correct fit to existing Stationary Compactor;
- Company qualifications and experience;
- List of references, including those with product track record in cold climates;
- Location of nearest qualified product parts & service provider;
- Purchase price, including delivery charges, FOB Middlebury, VT;
- Best delivery date after award in August;
- Warranty Option, if available.
- 3. The bids may also list options and prices for: (a) one extra set of tire rims; and (2) an extended warranty. These options are for informational purposes only and will not be considered criteria for selecting the winning bid.

Financing/leasing options are unnecessary for inclusion in the bid. Terms: Net 30 days.

The ACSWMD will accept bids by mail or hand delivery (1223 Rt. 7 South, Middlebury, VT 05753); by e-mail (teri@acswmd.org); or by fax ((802) 388-0271). Bidders are encouraged to call the office to confirm receipt of bids, as late bids will be rejected. Bids will remain confidential until opened on August 4, 2021.

BID EVALUATION

Each bid will be publicly opened and reviewed by ACSWMD staff at the ACSWMD offices located at 1223 Rt. 7 South, Middlebury, VT, at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, August 4, 2021. Staff will review the bids with the ACSWMD Executive Board on August 4, 2021 at 4:30 PM, and with the full Board of Supervisors (BOS) on August 19, 2021, with the intent to contact the successful bidder by August 20, 2021, or as soon as the BOS makes its award.

Responses to this RFB will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- o The ability of the firm to ship the product within 120 days of the award of bid;
- o Local availability of parts and servicing;
- o Price;
- o Purchase agreement terms and conditions;
- o Availability of product warranty;
- o Extent to which the proposed product meets or exceeds the minimum specifications;
- o Experience (including cold-climate) and reputability of product;
- o Reputability and experience of vendor;
